Advice for those intending to visit the FEDAGA Shop on Sunday 22nd February

FEDAGA has been let down by the supplier of seed potatoes. The delivery arranged for Saturday 21st February failed to appear. This means that there will only be onions and shallots available at the Shop on Sunday 22nd February between 2 and 3.30pm.

ONIONS: Sturon and Red Baron

Onions come in loose 250g bags and cost £1.

SHALLOTS: Gourmet and Red Sun.

Shallots come in loose bags of 500g and cost £2.

For Sunday, if you intend to visit, please bring the exact amount as there is no "float" for change available. This will be rectified for next week.

We hope a delivery can be arranged for the coming week and the site orders can be distributed. If you have ordered through your site, please be patient. You will have your order as soon as can be arranged.

If you would like to buy seed potatoes from the FEDAGA Shop, we anticipate they will be available from Sunday 1st March. The Shop will be open on Sundays through March by arrangement with the Inverleith Allotments Site Committee between 2 and 3.30pm. The varieties available will diminish quickly so don't delay if you want a decent choice.

FIRST EARLIES: Casablanca, Duke of York, Red Duke of York, Lady Christl, Maris Bard, Sharpe's Express, Foremost.

SECOND EARLIES: Kestrel, Nadine, Wilja, Maris Peer, Catriona, Vivaldi.

MAIN CROPS: Cara, King Edward, Maris Piper, Sarpo Mira, Rooster, Picasso.

SALADS: Pink Fir Apple, Charlotte, International Kidney.

All seed potatoes come in 2.5kg bags except for Vivaldi and Rooster which are 2kg.
